Getting here and Getting around

We're less than 10 minutes from the airport and about 15 minutes from downtown by car. If you don't have your own car we can help you figure out some other ways to get around during your stay. Lyft and Uber are good options in a pinch and will cost you around \$20 each way to downtown. The Music City Train station and MTA bus stops are also nearby (www.musiccitystar.org and www.nashvillemta.org respectively)

Entry

There is a keypad for entry and the code is **3142**. **Please do not share this with anyone outside of the household**. Please lock the doors when you leave and at night. Otherwise it is pretty safe to leave unlocked during the day when people are coming in and out.

TO LOCK: close the door and press 3142 and turn the lock, when the light stops flashing you can turn the lock upright and the door will be locked.

TO UNLOCK: Press 3142 and turn the lock away from the frame while the light is flashing and you will be able to open the door.

- As much as possible, please **just keep the space in the same order you find it**. We keep our rates low and don't charge cleaning fees, so we appreciate your help with keeping everything clean and tidy.
- **Please Remove your shoes at the front and back doors** to save wear on the floors and clean up spills promptly. There are cleaning supplies under the sink in the kitchen. For additional necessary items you will need to purchase your own supplies
- If You cook, please clean up after yourself right away.
- Please do not leave dishes in the sink or dirty dishes in the dishwasher at any time.

TRASH

- There are two receptacles for trash in the kitchen and one in each bathroom. There are also two outdoor receptacles for trash and recycling at both houses and both can be taken out to the bins on the street in front of Diane's house (black for trash, blue/green for recycling). Glass is also picked up, but must be separated. Pickup is Friday.
- Thermostats in hallways may be adjusted, but please keep it set between 68 and 72 degrees. Help yourself to extra blankets or fans if needed.
- Please **conserve** water and power during your stay, turn off lights, running water, towel use, etc. Be kind to Mother Earth!
- Quiet hours are 10pm to 8am. Please be mindful of other guests in the house and the neighbors.
- Please don't bring other guests into the home without permission!!
- Pets are not allowed except under rare circumstances.
- **No Smoking Inside** ever. No drugs or excessive alcohol!!
